If you wish to play golf at our course, follow the guidelines below – developed in conjunction with NZ Golf and the Government and allow you to enjoy our facilities in a safe manner

The Clubhouse (including foyer) will remain closed, please note this means no toilet or water facilities are available for use.

## OPEN for play from Tuesday 28 April

Play is only possible with others from  
within your bubble.

Do not arrange to meet  
anyone else to play.

- **All players (member or casual) MUST book a tee time using our online system. To comply with the Government rules around traceability, we must have a record of who is using the facilities.**

To book, you can access the online system via [www.bookandplaygolf.com](http://www.bookandplaygolf.com) or use the Book Now tab on our website [www.riversdalebeachgolfclub.co.nz](http://www.riversdalebeachgolfclub.co.nz). If you are unable to book online, please call 04 499 3444 between 8am – 4pm Monday to Friday.

- Members can log in and book tee times with their details. Visitors should provide first initial and surname, and a valid phone

number, for every player in the appropriate fields when processing their payment for green fees. No cash facilities are available.

- No score cards are to be submitted. Scores will not count towards handicap index until after Level 3.
- No shared equipment, this includes carts and clubs. The flag pins and bunker rakes will not be in place.
- Play is only possible for those playing alone or playing with others from within their bubble. Do not arrange to meet anyone else to play.

- Maintain at least 2m physical distance from other course users and respect the tee times (15 minute spacing). Golfers should arrive in time and ready to tee off at their booked time, and leave the facilities immediately after finishing play.

- No tournaments, matches or club days to be held until further notice.

- **Please do not BYO alcohol.** Even during lockdown, the Club is a licensed premises and anybody disregarding this puts our ability to trade at risk when we are allowed to reopen. Enjoy your round, then enjoy your refreshment at home in your bubble.
