

LOCAL COURSE RULES - LEVEL 2

TEE BOOKING/CHECK IN AND CONTACT TRACING

Players <u>MUST</u> use the online Booking System to reserve their tee time. When you arrive and before you tee off, you need to Check-In using the Kiosk (in the foyer) to ensure contact tracing requirements are met.

*The only exception to this rule is for Skinners, Ladies Golf and Club Days. For these events, contact tracing is completed manually by the duty person.

If you enter the Clubhouse, you must sign in and out on the sheet, located just through the interior door.

BUNKERS - All rakes have to be removed from bunkers

"When a players ball lies in a bunker which has had the rake removed, the player may take relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

Reference Point: Spot of the original ball. Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: one club length but with these limits;

- Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must remain in the bunker.

SCORING IN STROKEPLAY - Score Cards

Players should enter their own hole scores on the scorecard (it is not necessary for a marker to do it).

It is not necessary to have a marker physically certify the players hole scores, a verbal certification should take place and the markers name should be printed on the card by the player. If a fellow competitors name or 7 digit ID appears on the scorecard, it is deemed that verbal certification has been agreed and completed.

FLAG STICK

The flag stick is to remain in the hole at all times.

HOLING OUT

A ball is deemed to be holed with the next stroke if it is within 30cm of the hole – the equivalent of the length of a standard putter grip. This does not prevent a player in match play conceding a stroke that is outside this length.
